

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES:

- Abstracts must be in English and include sufficient information for reviewers to judge the nature and significance of the topic.
- The abstract should elaborate the investigative strategy that will be taken for the work and not merely list topics to be discussed.
- It should have an intro, body and conclusion.
- It is a well-developed paragraph, should be exact in wording, and must be understandable to a wide audience.
- Please ensure you thoroughly check your submission for spelling and grammatical errors.
- If your title includes scientific notation, Greek letters, bold, italics, or other special characters/symbols, do make sure they appear correctly.
- All abstracts must be submitted in electronic format
- doc/.docx file formats are accepted.
- Abstracts should be no more than 250 words, formatted in Microsoft Word, and single-spaced, using size 12 Times New Roman font.
- Abstract title, references, tables, images and acknowledgements are not included in the word count.
- No abstracts will be accepted for review after 20 February 2018.
